### Maputo – Winner Announced: Mozambican University Students Participate in a Gas-Focused Essay Contest

University students from distinguished universities across Mozambique participated in a Gas-Focused Essay Contest **organized by The CWC Group, and Sponsored by Anadarko and Mozambique LNG, as part of the Mozambique Gas Summit**. The contest is part of Educational Partnerships initiative in which companies support and **encourage university degrees that enable skilled professionals** in areas of engineering, geology, oil and gas exploration and others, much needed for the sustainable development of Mozambique's gas industry and the future of the country's economy.
